

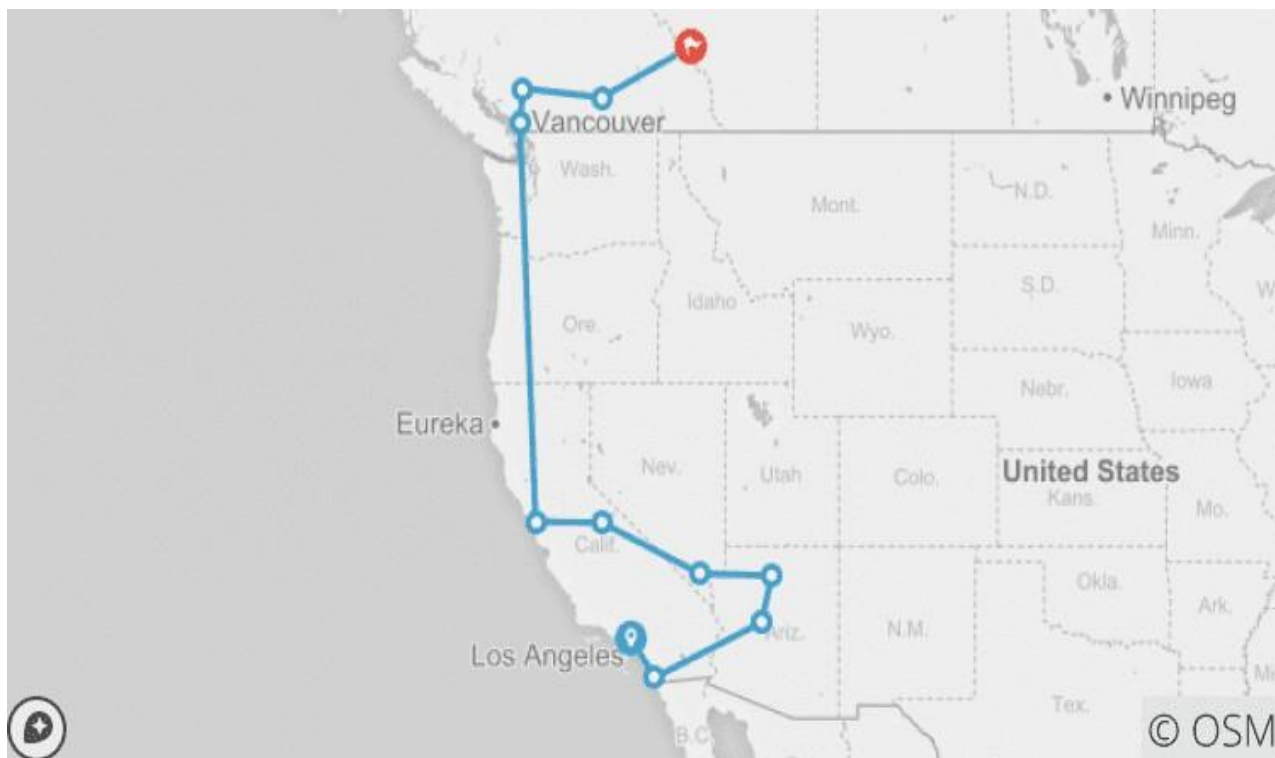

Introduction

Shred and carve your way through the USA and Canada on this wintry road trip of epic proportions. From sunny LA to the snow-covered slopes of Whistler, Kelowna and Banff, you'll have heaps of opportunities to perfect your skiing or snowboarding technique. Throw in some quality après-ski sessions, a wild night (or two) in Vegas and some winter sun in San Diego, San Francisco and the grandest of all canyons, and you've got yourself one unforgettable adventure.

Day 1: Los Angeles to San Diego
